The Yeongsan River is one of the four major waterways in South Korea, often called the "backbone" of the Jeolla region. It is about 130 km long, flowing from Damyang County, past Gwangju, to the West Sea at Mokpo. Historically, the river was vital for rice farming on the fertile Naju Plain and served as a major trade route with busy ports like Yeongsanpo. In 1981, a large dam was built at its end to control flooding and store fresh water. It is called the "Yeongsangang Estuary Bank." However, this changed the river's flow and that has also



affected the natural environment. Today, the Yeongsan River is still vital to the people and environment of Jeolla Province and its banks are also popular places for leisure, with bike paths and parks that allow locals and visitors to enjoy the peaceful scenery. The bike path that follows the Yeongsan River is around 133km long and is very beautiful. Why don't you visit there some day?

Seomfingang



The Seomjin River, called the "Seomjingang" in Korean, is one of Korea's most pristine waterways. It is a vital artery of the southwestern peninsula. Renowned not merely for its substantial length but for the untouched natural landscapes it carves through, the Seomjin's meandering path serves as both a geographical landmark and a profound cultural touchstone. Its course distinguishes it from other major rivers, offering a powerful sense of quiet beauty and historical depth. The river's journey commences on the slopes of Palgongsan Mountain in Jinan County, Jeollabuk-do Province. From this mountainous source, the Seomjin embarks on a sinuous southward and westward flow, traversing three distinct administrative regions. It first defines the boundaries of Jeollabuk-do, then continues its passage through Jeollanam-do, and finally marks the border with Gyeongsangnam-do before culminating in Gwangyang Bay on the South Sea. This lengthy passage connects culturally rich, mountainous inland areas like Imsil and Gokseong with coastal hubs like Hadong and Gwangyang, thereby linking diverse local histories and ecosystems. The convergence of these provinces along its banks contributes significantly to the unique character of the Seomjin River basin. The Seomjin River has become a premier destination for recreational enthusiasts, largely due to the acclaimed bicycle path that traces its route. The Seomjin River Bicycle Path offers cyclists a panoramic journey that allows for an intimate engagement with the surrounding environment. Riders are treated to views of untouched valleys, thick riverside forests, and traditional Korean villages. This trail provides numerous opportunities for leisure, including an MTB experience park, numerous creative photo spots and flowers all year round. In the spring, in particular, riders are treated to a trail lined with cherry blossoms.
