Jirisan






Have you heard of Jirisan? This iconic and expansive mountain range dominates the southern expanse of South Korea, traversing the administrative boundaries of Jeonbuk, Jeonnam, and Gyeongnam provinces. Standing majestically at 1915 meters, it proudly claims its place as the nation's second-highest peak, surpassed only by Hallasan on Jeju Island.

Distinct from many international trekking destinations, Jirisan offers strategically placed shelters providing essential amenities such as readily available water refills, instant rice, and powdered energy drinks. These communal spaces facilitate self-catering and, with prior reservation, offer overnight accommodation. While basic restrooms are provided, handwashing facilities are notably absent, necessitating the use of wet wipes. Though the ascent typically commences at 2:30 AM, involving two arduous days of trekking, for avid hikers, Jirisan promises an undeniably unforgettable and profoundly rewarding experience
